Activities carried out during this 5-day practice include topography analysis for mining exploration, blocking area, information for the plantation sector, inventory for the industrial forest, measurement of the frame of basic horizontal, structuring the outer boundaries of GWUF, reconstructing triangulation points with reference to GWUF control points, etc.

“GWUF natural resources for practical work are really complete, infrastructure and facilities are also adequate. In the future, we will continue this year which has been done in GWUF so that there is sustainability with the interests of the GWUF management so that Adi Sanggoro Vocational High School has a contribution to GWUF.
