"At least, this training program has laid the foundations of how to manage the forest in the future, not only complaining of budget constraints but also managing limited human resources in each KPH area" said Basar Manulang.

Basar Manulang said that GWUF was a successful example on how to manage forests without the assistance of the national budget from the government this was should not be a problem, but a challenge and an opportunity.
